

NZ Safety Blackwoods – Greens “What’s in Your Wheelbarrow?” Promotion Terms & Conditions

1. Promoter

The promoter is NZ Safety Blackwoods, 87–91 Kerrs Road, Wiri, Auckland, New Zealand.

2. Eligibility

Entry into the Competition is open to New Zealand citizens and New Zealand residents who are 18 years or older. The winning recipient may be required to provide proof of age before receiving the prize.

Employees of the Promoter, the Promoter’s associated companies, the Promoter’s agencies associated with this promotion, and each of their immediate families (i.e. spouse, parent, child, or sibling) are ineligible to enter.

3. Promotional Period

The Competition commences **7:00 AM (NZST) on 29th October 2025** and concludes **11:59 PM (NZST) on 30th November 2025** (“Promotional Period”).

4. How to Enter

To enter, entrants must, during the Promotional Period:

- Upload a photo of a unique or fun way they use their Greens Wheelbarrow (e.g. child’s joyride, BBQ ice bucket, or creative use).

Entrants are responsible for any expenses they incur in entering the competition. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost, or misdirected entries due to technical disruptions, network congestion, or any other reason.

5. Entry Conditions

Entrants warrant that their entry (photo) is original, does not breach any intellectual property rights, and does not contain objectionable, defamatory, or offensive content.

Entrants indemnify the Promoter and its associated agencies against any loss, costs, or liability arising from any breach of these terms or third-party rights.

6. Prize Details

There are **five (5)** prizes to be won. Each prize is one (1) **limited-edition Greens 50-Year Anniversary T-shirt size XL**.

- Prizes, or any unused portion of the prize, are not transferable, exchangeable, or redeemable for cash.
- Sizes and styles are subject to availability.
- If any prize is unavailable, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize with one of equal value and/or specification.

7. Prize Draw

The prize draw will take place at the NZ Safety Blackwoods Head Office, 87–91 Kerrs Road, Wiri, Manukau 2241, on **4th December 2025**, in the presence of an independent witness.

Winners will be notified by phone or email within **7 working days** of the draw.

Should any prize remain unclaimed after **14 days** of initial notification, an unclaimed prize draw will take place on **18th December 2025** at the same time and location. Winners of any redraw will be notified within 7 working days.

8. Prize Collection

Prizes must be collected in person from the winner’s nominated NZ Safety Blackwoods Trade Centre. Winners will be required to present valid photo identification at the time of collection.

Prizes must be collected within 30 days of notification unless otherwise agreed with the Promoter. Failure to collect within this timeframe may result in forfeiture and a redraw.

9. Verification and Disqualification

The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and disqualify any that include objectionable content, profanity, or potentially insulting or defamatory material, or that are not in accordance with these Terms.

Entrants using fraudulent or misleading methods of entry will be disqualified. The Promoter reserves the right to recover damages or compensation from any entrant involved in misconduct.

10. Publicity

By accepting a prize, winners agree to participate in reasonable media and promotional activities (including photography, filming, or social media content) without additional compensation.

The Promoter may publish winners' names, images, and entries on its website, social channels, and marketing materials.

11. Privacy

The Promoter is bound by the Privacy Act 2020. Entry into the competition is deemed consent to the collection, storage, and use of personal information in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy. Personal details will be used solely for the purpose of administering the competition and will not be disclosed to third parties except as required by law.

12. Liability

The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage (including indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered in connection with the prize except where liability cannot be excluded by law.

The Promoter is not responsible for any technical error, network failure, or corruption that affects the administration, security, or fairness of the competition.

13. Force Majeure

If the competition cannot proceed as planned due to vandalism, power failure, natural disaster, strike, war, act of terrorism, computer virus, tampering, fraud, or any event beyond the Promoter's control, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the competition, subject to regulatory approval.

14. General

- The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- If a winner advises they do not wish to accept a prize, it will be forfeited and redrawn.
- Any tax liability arising from accepting the prize is the winner's responsibility.
- These Terms are governed by the laws of New Zealand.
